## *Is the War REALLY Over?*

The first war that comes to mind when asked the question, “Is the war *really* over?” is, of course, the one that’s supposed to be over in Iraq, even though our soldiers are being killed almost every day. But the war in Iraq isn’t the only one going on. People are killing each other all over the world. Why? Because the war inside human beings is far from over. The great majority of people on planet Earth are still locked into a primitive survival mode of consciousness that operates out of fear. Where there’s fear there is resistance, suspicion, hostile competition, resentment, anger, defensiveness and hate. These are the kinds of feelings that drown out compassion, cooperation, understanding and love. It’s simple. When a person operates out of fear—it’s impossible to operate from a place of love.

The outer world is the effect of our inner world. And as long as there are more people waging war inside themselves than are experiencing internal peace, the world will reflect that inner war as outer war. Every war on this planet, every murder, every upheaval is being fueled by the fire of fear that starts in the heart and mind of each individual. Are there people on the planet who operate primarily out of love? Sure. But right now it’s taking every one of them to counterbalance the constant barrage of fear still issuing forth from the collective warring mentality.

I truly believe that violence and crime are committed by human beings who are mentally and emotionally cut off from their soul. When people ignore their own soul, they automatically separate themselves from Spirit. Notice that I said they separate *themselves* from Spirit. From the perspective of Higher Truth there is no separation—the separation or isolation of the human spirit is an illusion. But as long as the illusion is believed, one acts out of that illusion and the results are a life of isolation, struggle, stress and manipulation. All of this is projected onto our world and is reflected back to us in the way we interact with each other at the levels of family, community, nation and world.

Each of us must assume spiritual responsibility for finding ways to lift ourselves out of fear and into a resonance with the higher energies of Spirit. It’s time we learn to trust God as our guide, protector, inspiration and strength. As we do, one day there will be more of us that love than those who hate, and we will begin to feel the warm winds of peace blowing in our direction.

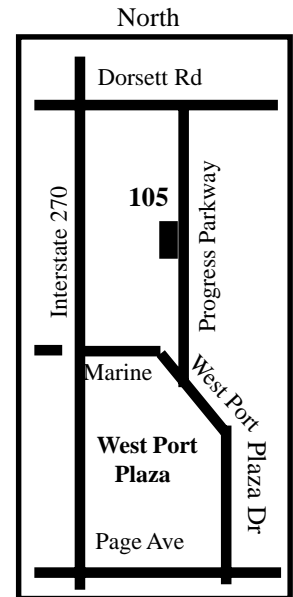

# Relationship Reflections

## *Relationships: Improving the Old, Co-Creating the New*

Good communication is the foundation of any relationship. What we may not know is that so much of the strife in relationships is caused when a person assumes that everyone sees the world the same way he or she does. Understanding that there are innate differences in the basic worldview of each individual helps us see beyond this common barrier.

One terrific tool for getting in touch with your own worldview is the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator® (MBTI®). Learning about your brain type and your innate temperament creates a series of *Aha!* experiences. You begin to see that what is happening in your relationships with a partner or others is typical, and that realization facilitates both non-judgment and a greater degree of tolerance.

Once we reframe the behavior of others and begin to see it as *normal for them*, we can then discuss feelings and possible alternatives to various problems without assuming our partner is just being contrary and hard to get along with. Adopting this frame of reference opens the door to better communication and allows us to focus our energy on the real issues between us.

Author Lenore Thompson, in her book *Personality Type: An Owner's Manual*, uses the interactions of the *Star Trek* characters as an example of how using a "type" strategy can facilitate better communications. Captain Kirk and Engineer Scott are often obliged to work together to assure the future of the starship *Enterprise*. When in crisis, Kirk relies on quick, imaginative and global responses intended to potentially transform the inherent danger in the situation. Scotty, his engineer, is charged with the task of carrying out his Captain's lofty solutions by translating them into actionable details. In response to the Captain's ideas Scotty often replies, "I cannot change the laws of physics, Captain!" or "I have to have more TIME!"

Scotty then employs his detailed knowledge of how the ship works to force Kirk into considering the logical probabilities of his recommendations. Scotty gradually pushes Kirk into greater specificity, until the engineer has enough information to apply the original idea as a creative response to the threat they face. Using, instead of resisting, the innate differences between them creates a synergy that is more powerful than either approach has on its own.

## *Healing Relationships*

You may spend years falling in and out of love before you realize that there is another dimension to love that you haven't as yet understood. As you focus more and more on Love (notice the capital "L"), you will realize that every unfinished relationship that you have ever had must be healed. A healed relationship doesn't mean fixing it, or making it like it was in the beginning with all the bells and whistles, or that the person who left will return, or that you must return to a relationship with which you are finished. Healing a relationship can be accomplished without ever speaking to that person again or seeing that person in form again. Healing can be accomplished even if the other person has crossed over and no longer has a physical form. How? By understanding that healing happens in your own consciousness. It's called *forgiveness*.

True forgiveness is the successful severing of the emotional umbilical cords that energetically attach you to those events or people which have generated anger, resentment or victimhood in your consciousness. The journey into true forgiveness begins with the *willingness* to forgive, which leads you into nonresistance toward the person you want to forgive. Nonresistance enables you to step out of the emotional drama into the role of the Onlooker or Observer who can ask the question, "How is this person serving me?" When you can objectively appreciate the lessons this person has offered you, you will move into compassion ~ and that's when the journey into forgiveness truly begins.

Relationships exist to speed up the journey back to God. When a relationship is healed, the ego-self stops fighting to win, stops seeking justice, stops trying to manipulate everything to turn out the way it wants it to. When separation is healed, when there is wholeness instead of fragmented parts of yourself, there can be no more hurt and no more pain. There is only Love. This is spiritual maturity. This is spiritual confidence. This is soul-esteem.
